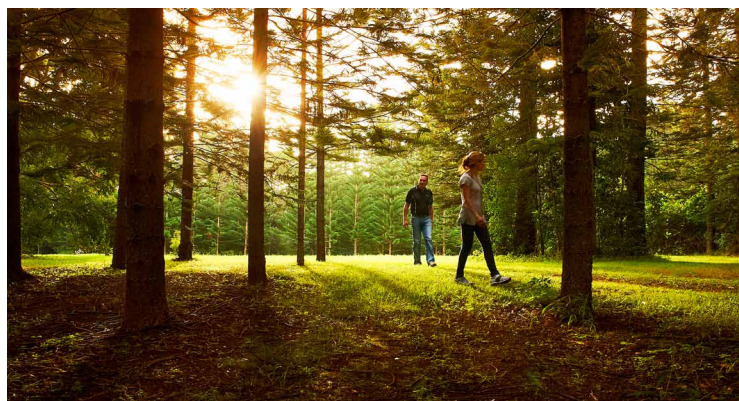

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Day 1 – Saturday 19 July 2014 (L in Flight, D) Brisbane – Norfolk / Dinner at Hotel / Sound and Light Show

On arrival you met by our local ground operator - Pinetree Tours and transferred to The Paradise Hotel Resort. Nightfall at Kingston brings a different mood to the Convict Settlement. With the dramatic use of real life sounds, theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as Pinetree Tours takes you through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era.

Day 2 – Sunday 20 July 2014 (B, D) Half Day Tour / Rock 'n' Roll Night as a Convict

This morning visit historic Kingston, Cascade, Longridge and much more on a half day orientation tour. Tonight get ready to rock your convict suit! A fun night out for all ages. Dress as a convict and join in with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing and lots of dancing.

Day 3 – Monday 21 July 2014 (B, D) Christian's 4WD Tour OR Culla and Co / Fish Fry / Show

Today you have a choice of tours. You can choose between a 4WD trip and Culla and Co's carriage ride. If you choose the 4WD trip you'll join John and his Island staff - all direct descendants of the Bounty Mutineers; on an exciting 3 hour tour to parts of Norfolk only accessible by 4WD. If you choose Culla and Co you will clip-clop you down memory lane on the 2 hour Steele's Point Carousel Horse and Carriage Tour. Late this afternoon enjoy a feast of Island dishes as you watch the sun set from Puppies' Point on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline and enjoy some fabulous entertainment.

Day 4 – Tuesday 22 July 2014 (B, D) Cyclorama / Dinner at Local Restaurant / Rock 'n' Roll Concert

During the week there will be optional dance workshops held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday morning. Cost of these is not included in your package but instead nominal fees can be paid on entrance at Rawson Hall where the workshops will be held. This afternoon we will head off to Cyclorama, an unforgettable experience. Walk inside the continuous 360 degree panoramic painting that traces the history of the Bounty leaving England through Tahiti, Pitcairn Island and arrival at Norfolk Island in 1856. After dinner the coach will transfer you to Rawson Hall where tonight's concert will be held. Sit and watch the concert or dance the night away.

Day 5 – Wednesday 23 July 2014 (B, D) Dinner at Local Restaurant / Rock 'n' Roll Concert

Optional workshops this morning include Intermediate Rock & Roll and Swing Jive. If you'd like to join in make your way to Rawson Hall and nominal fees for entrance to the workshop can be paid on entry. After dinner the coach will transfer you to Rawson Hall where tonight's concert will be held. Artists performing this week include Frankie J Holden, Wilbur Wilde and Tom Sharplin. Don't forget your dancing shoes.

Day 6 – Thursday 24 July 2014 (B, D) Convict Settlement Tour / Dinner Local Restaurant / Rock 'n' Roll Concert

Optional workshops this morning include Intermediate Rock & Roll and Partner Dance plus Line Dance. If you'd like to join in make your way to Rawson Hall and nominal fees for entrance to the workshop can be paid on entry. This afternoon join Pinetree Tours on an in-depth tour of the historic Georgian Settlement of Kingston. Walk through the cemetery and hear the history of interesting convict and colonial headstones and hear stories of the houses along Quality Row. After dinner the coach will transfer you to Rawson Hall where tonight's concert will be held. Another fabulous night of entertainment.

Day 7 – Friday 25 July 2014 (B, D) Glass Bottom Boat / Farewell Dinner and Dance Night

Today at a time to be advised, view beautiful coral gardens and tropical fish inside the calm crystal waters of Norfolk's lagoon. Donald and John provide full and interesting commentary on the environment tour. Tonight another fabulous rock 'n' roll event with a Gala Dinner and concert. The coach will transfer you to and from the venue.

Day 8 – Saturday 26 July 2014 (B, L in flight) Depart Norfolk

This morning take your choice of a stroll through One Hundred Acres Reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. At the end of the walk everyone will meet up on the cliff top for a delicious breakfast barbecue. This afternoon you will be transferred to Norfolk Airport in time for your flight home.



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
