Day 1 Monday 3rd August Depart Melbourne [In-Flight Meals]

We meet at the Melbourne International Airport early evening for our Emirates flight to London departing at 9:15pm.

Day 2 Tuesday 4th August London [B/D]

We arrive into Dubai for a short transit, before our final leg to London. We arrive into London at 12:25pm. We are met by our Tour Manager upon arrival and transfer to hotel. The remainder of day is free at leisure. Dinner will be enjoyed at the hotel this evening.

Hotel: London Tower Hotel or similar - 3 nights' accommodation in Run of House room

Day 3 Wednesday 5th August London [B]

Today we experience a half day guided tour of London including entrance to the Tower of London. The afternoon is free at leisure. This evening we are treated to a West-End show.

Enjoy a half day guided tour with local guide including entrance to Edinburgh Castle, before an afternoon at leisure. An exciting evening is in store as we experience 'Taste of Scotland' – Scottish 3-course dinner and show.

Day 10 Wednesday 12th August Edinburgh – Blair Atholl - Inverness

Today we drive along the Nine Glens of Antrim, stopping at Giant's Causeway and we enter the Giant's Causeway Visitor Centre. We then transfer to Londonderry and join a guided tour of the old city walls of Derry with local guide.

Hotel: Maldron Hotel Derry or similar – 1-night accommodation in Run of House room

Day 15 Monday 17th August

Londonderry – Donegal – Sligo – Westport (280kms, 5hrs)

[B/D]

This morning we venture to Donegal and take a guided tour of Donegal Castle. We then drive to Sligo and walk to Knockarea hill to view Neolithic Tomb. Later continue to Westport and meet our local guide for a city highlights tour. A 2-course dinner at our hotel this evening.

Hotel: Hotel Westport – Leisure Spa and Conference or similar – 1-night accommodation in Run of House room

Day 16 Tuesday 18th August

Westport - Galway

[B]

Today we drive to Kylemore and visit the Abbey and gardens, then continue to Galway. This afternoon has us join a guided tour of Galway with our local guide.

Hotel: Jury's Inn Galway or similar – 2 night's accommodation in Run of House room

Day 17 Wednesday 19th August

Galway

After breakfast, the day is yours to explore as you wish. A 2-course dinner will be had at local restaurant/pub to-night. Later we enjoy an evening performance.

Day 18 Thursday 20th August

Galway – Cliffs of Moher – Limerick (155kms, 3.30hrs)

We drive through the Burren for a visit to the Cliffs of Moher Visitor's Centre, before later continuing to Limerick. Hotel: Castleroy Park Hotel or similar – 1-night accommodation in Run of House room

Day 19 Friday 21st August

Limerick – Dingle Peninsula - Killarney

We relax in the coach this morning as we drive along Shannon Estuary into County Kerry and stop in Slea Head at the westernmost point of mainland Ireland. Later we drive to Dingle for a stop- time permitting, before reaching Killarney. Enjoy a 2-course dinner at the hotel this evening.

Hotel: Brehon Hotel or similar – 2 night's accommodation in Run of House room

Day 20 Saturday 22nd August

Killarney – Ring of Kerry - Killarney

An enjoyable morning awaits as we visit Ross Castle. Later we drive to Kenmare and continue along the Ring of Kerry including views at Moll's Gap and Ladies' View. We visit the Kerry Bog Village Museum in Glenbeigh, before returning to Killarney.

Day 21 Sunday 23rd August

Killarney – Kinsale - Cork (117kms, 2.30hrs)

After breakfast we travel to Kinsale and visit Charles Fort. Free time in Kinsale to explore. We continue to Cork where we join a guided tour with local guide, with entry to Saint Fin Barre's Cathedral. 2-course dinner at local restaurant/pub tonight, before an evening performance.

Cork – Blarney - Waterford (121kms, 2.30hrs)

All bookings are subject to availability and price confirmation at the time of booking.

A group is defined as 10 or more passengers travelling together; if the number of passengers decreases from those quoted above the per passenger cost may increase and could be subject to a change of the conditions of travel.

Standard Deposit: On receipt of this \$1000.00 deposit your booking will be requested and confirmed subject to availability of all services. Receipt of payment signifies the acceptance of the costs of services provided, and the booking conditions contained herein. Additional deposits such as those charged by hotels, airlines, cruise companies or local operators will be invoiced to you, however, are subject to advice from our operators. Cancellation fees and conditions of these suppliers over and above those written below will be advised to you in writing. (Please note all credit card charges have a surcharge and will appear on your statement as Travel Pay).

Final Payment: Payment for the balance of services is due to our office no later than the 20th May 2020. If you fail to meet payment conditions, Go See Touring / All About Travel / Operations Europe reserves the right to cancel the booking and apply the appropriate cancellation charges. Late payment may result in late issue of documentation which will not be issued until the company is in receipt of full payment. (Please note all credit card charges have a surcharge and will appear on your statement as Travel Pay).

Amendment Fees: Any changes to quotes are subject to availability and confirmation. Amendments made less than 60 days prior to departure may be considered as cancellations and are subject to the cancellation fees advised at the time of confirmation.

Cancellation: All cancellations must be made in writing to Go See Touring / All About Travel. All bookings are subject to cancellation fees as outlined below <u>unless otherwise stated at the time of confirmation</u>.

Upon Confirmation: Non-refundable deposit plus any charges already levied by our ground operators or hotels.

Any deposits paid for airfares or other arrangements are also non-refundable.

61+ Days: Forfeit of non-refundable deposit only

0-60 Days: 100% cancellation fees.

Cancellation of either all or part of the services by individuals within the group will incur 100%

cancellation penalty.

After Departure: 100% cancellation fee. There is no refund applicable on unused services on a group or indi-

Itinerary: Every effort is made to ensure descriptions and details are correct at the time of quoting. The client/s recognizes and accepts that subsequent changes can occur. It is important to reconfirm brochure/travel details at the time of reservation. Go See Touring / All About Travel / Operations Europe and/or servants and/or ticket agents may change an itinerary/schedule to achieve sensible parallel to an originally planned tour where local conditions or changed circumstances warrant same.
