A quick visit to the local sawmill is an added bonus. The tour travels to Alison Christian's humble home where you sample the range of cheeses with tasty condiments and complementary wine. Enjoy the scenic ocean and valley views from the veranda whilst cheesemaker John gives you an informative talk. Tonight, transfer to Paradise hotel for dinner followed by the last show from your wonderful host of entertainers for the week.

Day 7 – Friday 09 July 2021 - Behind the Hedges Tour / Farewell Dinner at Governor's Lodge
