Depart Sydney 9.30pm / Arrive Rarotonga 7.00am / Resort Orientation / Welcome Drinks & Dinner

Welcome to the start of your tropical holiday. Meet Rodney Vincent at Melbourne Domestic Airport, Departures Hall. Depart on Jetstar and arrive in Sydney. For those ex-Sydney, check in 2 hours prior. Departing on Jetstar at 9.30pm crossing the international date line, arrive Rarotonga at 7.00am. Kia Orana & welcome to the Cook Islands! Upon arrival into Rarotonga, we go through Customs, and are greeted by a local representative and transferred to Edgewater Resort, our home for the duration of our holiday. This afternoon there will be an orientation of the resort where you will be introduced to the activities staff and features available to you throughout your stay at the Resort and on the island. Meet at Mal's Bar for happy hour drinks (Drinks are at own expense) before dinner at the Spaghetti House this evening.

Day 2 Saturday 28 February 2026 Punanga Nui Market / Rodney Sings / Edgewater Island Night Feast & Show [B, D

Today visit Rarotonga's Punanga Nui Market which offers a wide range of island gifts and handicrafts, black pearls, pearl shell, jewellery, pareu fabrics, clothing, local music and fresh local produce. Day 3 Sunday 1 March 2026 Rarotonga's Churches / Te Ara Museum / BBQ Under the Stars

Day 4 Monday 2 March 2026

Day 6 Wednesday 4 March 2026 Highland Paradise

This fascinating "open air museum" boasts spectacular views and showcases evidence of a historical lost village and survival of the Polynesian people. Day 8 Friday 6 March 2026

Depart Rarotonga 9.00am

A very early morning breakfast is in order today, as we head to the airport for our Jetstar flight departing at 9.00am. We cross back over the international dateline.

Day 9 Saturday 7 March 2026 Arrive Sydney 12.30pm / Depart Sydney 4.00pm / Arrive Melbourne 5.35pm

We cross back over the international date line, before arriving into Sydney at 12.30pm. After clearing customs and collecting luggage, for those travelling onto Melbourne with Rodney, we drop our bags off at the bag drop zone before catching the terminal shuttle to the Domestic Terminal. We depart on our Jetstar flight before arriving into Melbourne at 5.35pm. It is here that we say good-bye.
