Day 1 – Saturday 22 November Depart Brisbane 11.35am – Arrive Norfolk 3.45pm/ Dinner at the Boatshed

Day 2 – Sunday 23 November Sightseeing Tour / Dinner & Concert

The setting is 10 acres of magical Norfolk pines and bushland lit up like an enchanted forest. Meander along (or ride in the 'moon buggy') a gentle winding path whilst a descendant of one of the Bounty mutineers recites poetry written by past local poet Matt Bigg. Afterwards enjoy a light supper.

Day 4 – Tuesday 25 November Cultural Tour / Island Fish Fry

Join Pinetree Tours and delve into the rich culture and heritage of their forebears on the Island Culture Tour. Where the arts of weaving, cooking, dancing and our Norfolk Language were inherited from our mutineer ancestors and their Tahitian wives. Join us for a cooking demonstration, indulge in a taste of some of our traditional dishes, master our Tahitian Island dancing, try your hand at weaving and attempt some of the Norf'k Language. Late this afternoon, depart for 'Orn daa Cliff' a stunning cliff top setting on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline to watch the sunset. Enjoy a delicious feast of local Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by an Island dessert and tea or coffee. While you dine in paradise, you are treated to some local entertainment.

Day 5 - Wednesday 26 November Thanksgiving Day Picnic/ Progressive Dinner
