Day 1 - Thursday 16 July 2020 (D) Depart Adelaide 1:55PM (or Melbourne) - Arrive Sydney 4:15PM

On arrival in Sydney Transfer by shuttle to Holiday Inn Sydney Airport for an overnight stay. Relax and enjoy a 2-course dinner at your hotel. Accommodation: Holiday Inn Sydney Airport

Day 2 - Friday 17 July 2020 (B, D) Depart Sydney 9:50AM - Arrive Norfolk 1:25PM/Dinner at Paradise Hotel

Dress as a convict (outfits provided) and join in with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing and dancing. Great food and lots of fun.

Day 6 - Tuesday 21 July 2020 (B, L, D) 'A Little Bit Country - and a Little Bit Lunch' / Dinner with the Mutineers

Today transfer to the fabulous cliff top property Orn Daa Cliff for magnificent views as you enjoy lunch, a feast of fresh fried fish, Island dishes, salads and homemade bread followed by Island desserts. After lunch you will be entertained by our fabulous entertainers. Return to your hotel late afternoon. Experience a fun night full of laughter and sing along while getting a real look into the local culture and traditions. Day 7 - Wednesday 22 July (B,D) Breakfast Bush Walk / Dinner at Hilli

This morning take your choice of a stroll through One Hundred Acres Reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. If you prefer not to rise early and bush walk you'll be picked up a little later and taken to join the walkers at Anson Bay as they return from their walk and where you'll all enjoy a delicious breakfast barbecue on the clifftop. The rest of the day is at leisure and lunch is own arrangements. Tonight, dinner is at Hilli, a favourite with locals and visitors for its delicious seasonal cuisine.

Day 8 - Thursday 23 July 2020 (B, D) Behind the Hedges Tour / 'A Little Bit of Country - A Bit of Shindig'

Today travel to Anson Bay to see a demonstration at Norfolk's major pottery and browse at the Cottage Pottery shop. Following this, visit the Hilli Goat farm which produces its own cheese and skin products where you will see some of the happiest and healthiest dairy goats with a view on a stunning cliff top property. Enjoy morning tea at a scenic location, then on to Sweeties for an exclusive look at how chocolate is made on Norfolk Island. Next we visit a beautiful private garden Music Valley, where Jane will share with you her knowledge and stories. Finally, finish this informative tour with a visit to a magnificent Banyan tree on a private property. Tonight, enjoy dinner at your hotel followed by the last show from your wonderful host of entertainers for the week.
