Day 1 Friday 30 October 2020 Depart Sydney 9.10pm / Arrive Rarotonga 6.15am / Weaving Class / Dinner [B, D]

Welcome to the start of your tropical holiday. Meet Graeme & Lynne Hugo at Adelaide domestic airport for your flight to Sydney. Times to be advised. If travelling from another port, please contact us. Depart Sydney with Air New Zealand & cross the international date line. Kia Orana & welcome to the Cook Islands! Upon arrival into Rarotonga, we go through Customs, and are greeted by a representative from The Edgewater Resort & Spa and transferred to the Resort, our home for the duration of our holiday. Our rooms have been pre-booked and will be ready for us. We will have time to freshen up before a tropical breakfast. Day 2 Saturday 31 October 2020 Punanga Nui Market / Discover Rarotonga Tour / Edgewater Island Night Feast & Show [B, L, D]

Day 3 Sunday 1 November 2020 Rarotonga's Churches / BBQ Under the Stars [B, D]
