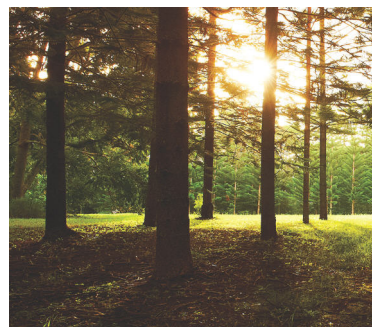

Day 1 – Thursday 13 May 2021 Depart Melbourne QF458 3:30PM – Arrive Sydney 4:55PM [D]

On arrival in Sydney Transfer by shuttle to your Sydney Airport hotel for an overnight stay. Relax and enjoy dinner at your hotel. Overnight Stamford Plaza Sydney Airport Hotel.

Day 2 – Friday 14 May 2021 Depart Sydney 9:50AM – Arrive Norfolk 1:25PM /Dinner at Castaway [B,D]

Early breakfast at the hotel this morning. The hotel shuttle will transfer you to the airport in time for your flight to Norfolk Island. On arrival in the main terminal you will be met by our local ground operator – Pinetree Tours and transferred to the Castaway, a charming centrally located hotel which will be your home for the next 7 nights. Dinner tonight will be at your hotel.

Day 3 – Saturday 15 May 2021 Half Day Orientation Tour / Progressive Dinner [B,D]

Pinetree Tours Half Day Orientation Tour is a must for every visitor. Visit historic Kingston, Cascade, Longridge and much more. See and hear about the famous convict buildings, beautiful beaches and golf course, the renowned Melanesian Chapel, local Government laws and lifestyle. Enjoy views from scenic spots on this full commentary conducted tour. Morning tea is included. Lunch today is own arrangements and the rest of the day is at leisure. Tonight, enjoy a 3-course meal progressing to different Norfolk Island family homes. A fun night and a great way to meet the local people and sample some of the Island dishes.

Day 4 – Sunday 16 May 2021 Convict Settlement Tour / 'Jailhouse Rock' Concert [B,D]

This morning and lunch are at leisure. Join Pinetree Tours on an in-depth tour of the historic Georgian Settlement of Kingston. Walk through the cemetery and hear the history of interesting convict and colonial headstones and hear stories of the houses along Quality Row. Walk through the ruins of the new gaol; see the Pier Store, boat shed and the crank mill. Afternoon tea is included. Transfer to Paradise Hotel & Resort for dinner. After dinner, your host Rodney performs alongside Lucky Starr & Geoff Jones. It promises to be a great night's entertainment.

Day 5 – Monday 17 May 2021 Pitcairn Settlers Village / Night as a Convict [B,D]

Today learn about the colourful history of Norfolk Island's most recent settlement – the Pitcairners and their descendants, on one of the last few remaining original settler's properties. Experience the history & culture of the Pitcairn Settlers. View the magnificent homestead gardens, including many of the traditional crops. Ride in Norfolk's first tour coach, a model A Ford and more! Approx. 2 ½ hours and includes light refreshments. Tonight, is a Night as a Convict. A fun night out for all ages. Dress as a convict (outfits supplied) and join in with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing and dancing. Great food and great fun.

Day 6 – Tuesday 18 May 2021 At leisure / Island Fish Fry [B,D]

Today is at leisure to catch your breath! Lunch is own arrangements. Late this afternoon we will watch the sun set from a stunning Cliff Top setting at 'Orn daa Cliff' on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline and enjoy a feast of local Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by an Island dessert and tea or coffee. While you dine in paradise, you are treated to some local entertainment.

Day 7 – Wednesday 19 May 2021 Breakfast Bush Walk / Cyclorama / Dinner at Hilli / Sound & Light Show [B,D]

This morning take your choice of a stroll through One Hundred Acres Reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. If you prefer not to rise early and bush walk you'll be picked up a little later and taken to join the walkers at Anson Bay as they return from their walk and where you'll all enjoy a delicious breakfast barbecue on the clifftop. Time at leisure until after lunch (own arrangements). This afternoon visit Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama is an unforgettable experience. Walk inside the circular painting and be surrounded by the immense artwork. A spectacular 3D effect is achieved in this painting with its detailed artwork and realistic perspective and the story that traces the history of the Bounty leaving England through Tahiti, Pitcairn Island and arrival at Norfolk Island in 1856. Dinner tonight is at Hilli, a lovely popular local restaurant. After dinner, transfer to Kingston where nightfall brings a different mood to the Convict Settlement. With the dramatic use of real-life sounds, theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as Pinetree Tours takes you through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era.

Day 8– Thursday 20 May 2021 Mootineers Cheese Tour / 'Jailhouse Rock' Concert [B,D]

This morning we visit Christian Brothers Cheese Company, a boutique dairy and Cheese producer started by two island brothers Glen and John Christian. The tour will take you through a local farm with beautiful ocean views, meet the milk cows, try the milking machine, see beehives and hear about producing the local honey. The tour travels to Alison Christian's home where you sample the range of cheeses with tasty condiments and complementary wine on the verandah with scenic ocean and valley views where cheese maker John will give an informative talk. This afternoon and lunch is at leisure. This evening transfer to Paradise Hotel for dinner. Followed by the final 'Jailhouse Rock' concert a big night of all the old favourite songs with Rodney Vincent, Lucky Starr and Geoff Jones. It will be a night to remember!

Day 9 – Friday 21 May 2021 Depart Norfolk 2:35PM – Arrive Sydney 4:30PM /8:50PM Arrive Melbourne [B]

Full buffet breakfast is served at your hotel. Pinetree Tours will transfer you to Norfolk Airport in time for your departure flight. For those travelling on to Melbourne, your onward Qantas flight departs Sydney at 7:15pm.
