Day 1 – Saturday 03 July 2021 - Depart Brisbane 10:15AM – Arrive Norfolk 1:25PM / Welcome Dinner (D)

Enjoy the scenic ocean and valley views from the veranda whilst cheesemaker John gives you an informative talk. Tonight enjoy a Night as a Convict. A fun night out for all ages. Dress as a convict (outfits provided) and join in with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing and dancing. Great food and lots of fun.

Day 4 – Tuesday 06 July 2021 - Glass Bohtham Boat/Fish Fry Lunch & 'A Little Bit Country'/ Dinner at Hotel (B, L, D)

View beautiful coral gardens and tropical fish inside the calm crystal waters of Norfolk's lagoon. Donald and Les provide full and interesting commentary on the environment tour. Tour time will depend on tides. View a film, visit a blacksmith's forge, the original homestead, a WWII Army hut and Museum of Memorabilia. Tonight, transfer to Paradise hotel for dinner followed by the last show from your wonderful host of entertainers for the week.

Day 7 – Friday 09 July 2021 - Behind the Hedges Tour / Farewell Dinner at South Pacific Resort (B, D)
