Day 1 Wednesday 14 May 2025 Depart Melbourne 2.25pm / Arrive Sydney 3.50pm [B/D]

Depart Sydney 9.30pm / Arrive Rarotonga 7.00am / Resort Orientation / Welcome Drinks & Dinner

Welcome to the start of your tropical holiday with Paul Costa. Check in 2 hours prior at Melbourne Domestic Airport, Departures Hall. Depart on Jetstar and arrive in Sydney. Depart Sydney on Jetstar at 9.30pm crossing the international date line, arrive Rarotonga at 7.00am. Kia Orana & welcome to the Cook Islands! Upon arrival into Rarotonga, we go through Customs and are greeted by a representative from DMCK and transferred to Edgewater Resort, our home for the duration of our holiday. This afternoon there will be an orientation of the resort where you will be introduced to the activities staff and features available to you throughout your stay at the resort and on the island. Late afternoon Paul will entertain us in the Heta Hut by the pool, whilst enjoying welcome cocktails (Drinks are at own expense) at sunset, before dinner at Spaghetti House this evening.

Day 2 Thursday 15 May 2025 Island Discovery Tour / Visit Local School / Progressive Dinner [B/D]

After breakfast this morning we embark on our Island Discovery Tour. This is an excellent introduction to the Cook Islands, and provides information on the country's history and culture, stopping along the way at fascinating historical and ceremonial sites. Light refreshments included on tour. Next, enjoy a relaxed morning with a visit to one of the islands local schools. Meet the students and spend some time with them and enjoy light refreshments. The remainder of today is at leisure for one of the following options: Free time for shopping including transfers or join a fishing charter to catch some local delicious fish or simply enjoy some R&R or activities at your fabulous resort. Day 3 Friday 16 May 2025 Koka Lagoon Cruise / Buffet at Edgewater [B/L/D]

Day 4 Saturday 17 May 2025 Punanga Nui Market / Poolside Drinks / Edgewater Island Night Feast & Show [B/L/D]

Enjoy tropical buffet breakfast this morning, before visiting Rarotonga's Punanga Nui Market. These vibrant markets offer a wide range of island gifts and handicrafts, black pearls, pearl shell, jewellery, pareu fabrics, clothing, local music and fresh local produce. Later enjoy an early lunch at The Lazy Trout before returning to our resort. This afternoon we join the activities staff and participate in a fun weaving class where we will make our own head ei (flower crown) and / or neck ei. Meet at Heta Hut at 5.00pm for happy hour drinks and Paul will perform for us. (Drinks are at own expense). Tonight, enjoy the fantastic in-house Polynesian Island Night & Show, including a sumptuous feast!

Day 5 Sunday 18 May 2025 Rarotonga's Churches / Te Ara Museum / BBQ Under the Stars [B/D]

Sunday is church day, when everything stops in Raro. We travel south to the village of Titikavaka to attend a church service at their Cook Islands Christian Church. Here we'll enjoy a wonderful experience! Hear the locals raise the roof with their renowned beautiful, spine-tingling singing! After the service, we join church members for a morning tea. Next we visit the Te Ara Museum, where we will see the world-class exhibition of the history of the Cook Islands with an environmental focus on ocean conservation. Lunch and the remainder of the afternoon are at leisure. Tonight, we indulge in a BBQ under the stars with resident band Ru and the Boys.

Day 6 Monday 19 May 2025 Highland Paradise [B/LR/D]

This morning we visit the very special Highland Paradise, situated high up in the rugged volcanic and beautiful mountains of Rarotonga. This fascinating "open air museum" boasts spectacular views and showcases evidence of a historical lost village and survival of the Polynesian people. This is a truly authentic experience situated on Raro's most sacred mountain! Learn about the intellectual know-how of the early signs of astrology to the barbaric rocks of sacrifice, including the navigational stones used to guide the 'vakas' to Aotearoa (*New Zealand*). Meander through the gardens with our guide, who points out medicinal and ritual plants. Light refreshments provided for lunch before returning to our resort. This afternoon is at leisure before we return up the mountain to Highland Paradise to enjoy an evening of unique and truly authentic cultural entertainment and feasting...prepare yourself for an evening of true Cook Islands exhilarating dance!

Day 7 Tuesday 20 May 2025 Marine & Wildlife Centre / Farewell Dinner [B/D]

We depart after breakfast to visit one of Rarotonga's newest attractions, featuring live exhibits and interactive displays. Discover coconut crabs, astonishing stonefish, stunning aquarium fish, inspiring natural history, cinema and so much more in this unique Cook Island Marine and Wildlife Centre. This afternoon we return to our resort to freshen up before departing for our farewell dinner at Tamarind House, a popular local restaurant.

Day 8 Wednesday 21 May 2025 Depart Rarotonga 9.00am [B]

A very early morning breakfast is in order today, as we head to the airport for our Jetstar flight departing at 9.00am. We cross back over the International Date Line.

Day 9 Thursday 22 May 2025 Arrive Sydney 12.30pm / Depart Sydney 4.00pm / Arrive Melbourne 5.35pm

We arrive into Sydney this afternoon at 12.30pm. After clearing customs and collecting our luggage, for those travelling onto Melbourne, we drop our bags off at the bag drop zone before catching the terminal shuttle to the Domestic Terminal. We depart on our Jetstar flight before arriving into Melbourne at 5.35pm. It is here that we say good-bye.
