Day 1 – Wednesday 29 October 2025 Depart Mel 6.00am / Dep Syd 10.45am - Arrive Norfolk 1.15pm / Welcome Dinner [D]

Welcome to the start of your Rockin' holiday on beautiful Norfolk Island with Paul Costa. Check in at the Qantas counter 2 hours prior to departure. Ex Melbourne, travel via Sydney. Touch down on Norfolk Island & welcome! Transfer by coach to your home for the next 7 nights, Paradise Hotel & Resort nestled in 11 acres of beautifully landscaped gardens. Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner at your hotel.

Day 2 – Thursday 30 October 2025 Orientation Tour / Island Fish Fry / Concert at Paradise Hotel [B, D]

This morning, Pinetree Tours Half Day Orientation Tour is a must for every visitor. Visit historic Kingston, Cascade, Longridge and much more. See and hear about the famous convict buildings, beautiful beaches and golf course, the renowned Melanesian Chapel, local Government laws and lifestyle. Morning tea is included. Late this afternoon depart for 'Orn daa Cliff', a stunning cliff top setting on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline to watch the sun set. Enjoy a delicious feast of local Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by an Island dessert and tea or coffee. While you dine in paradise, you are treated to some local entertainment. Tonight, after dinner, Paul will perform all your rockin' favourite songs.

Day 3 – Friday 31 October 2025 Cyclorama / Indulgence Tour / Dinner at Governor's Lodge [B, D]

This morning we take a short walk next door to Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama an unforgettable experience. This is one of only a handful of paintings of this type in the world and is based on an art form made popular in the 1800's. Walk inside the circular painting and be surrounded by the immense artwork. A spectacular 3D effect is achieved in this painting with its detailed artwork and realistic perspective and the story that traces the history of the Bounty leaving England through Tahiti, Pitcairn Island and arrival at Norfolk Island in 1856. This afternoon we start the Indulgence Tour on the south-eastern side of Norfolk Island, at Ball Bay, another stunning bay with magnificent ocean views! Here you will learn all about how we get fuel ashore, as this is where our supply is unloaded. We then move on to Steeles Point, to enjoy the sheltered valleys behind the coastal cliffs. From here, we head to the Captain Cook Monument, a scenic lookout where you will stand at the spot on the northern coast. We will finish the day the way all fantastic days should end, with wine, cheese & crackers on Mount Pitt. The Lookout gives a 360 degree view of the whole island. Tonight enjoy dinner at Governors Lodge.

Day 4 – Saturday 01 November 2025 Breakfast Bushwalk / Island Culture Tour / Night as a Convict [B, D]

This morning take your choice of a stroll through Palm Green Reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. At the end of the walk everyone will meet up on the cliff top for a delicious breakfast barbecue. If you prefer not to rise early and bush walk, but would like to have breakfast on the cliff top, join the walkers at Captain Cook as they return from their walk. This afternoon join Pinetree Tours and delve into the rich culture and heritage of their forebears on the Island Culture Tour. Where the arts of weaving, cooking, dancing and our Norfolk Language were inherited from our mutineer ancestors and their Tahitian wives. Join us for a cooking demonstration, indulge in a taste of some of our traditional dishes, master our Tahitian Island dancing, and attempt some of the Norfolk Language. Tonight, experience a night of hilarity with Night as a Convict Dinner on Norfolk Island. Dress up in convict suits (supplied) and join the Commandant for an entertaining evening of dining, music, dance and bawdy humour. Bring your sense of humour for an unforgettable evening!

Day 5 – Sunday 02 November 2025 Convict Settlement Tour / Dinner at Bounty Lodge [B, D]

This afternoon step back in time and immerse yourself in the captivating history of Norfolk Island with an expert-guided tour of the Kingston and Arthur's Vale Historic Area (KAVHA). Discover the stories behind the colonial headstones in the cemetery, the beautiful houses on Quality Row, and explore the New Gaol ruins, Pier Store, Boat Shed and Crank Mill. With knowledgeable guides sharing their insights and stories, you'll get firsthand experience of the intriguing past of this World Heritage Listed Georgian settlement. Top off your tour with a lovely afternoon tea. Tonight, enjoy a delicious dinner at local favourite, Bounty Lodge Bar & Grill located in a lovely old homestead.

Day 6 – Monday 03 November 2025 Paddock to Plate Tour / Progressive Dinner [B, D]

This morning depart on the new Paddock to Plate tour. Visit a market garden that supplies vegetables to the Island and learn about providing seasonal produce. We'll also tour a farm with beef cattle to understand the unique farming practices on Norfolk Island. Next, we'll visit a free-range chicken farm and learn how they supply the Island with farm fresh eggs. Our final stop will be at a local home for a delicious two-course lunch featuring local ingredients. Tonight, is a fabulous 3-course meal progressing to different Norfolk Island family homes. A fun night and a great way to meet the local people and sample some of the Island dishes.

Day 7 – Tuesday 04 November 2025 Glass Bottom Boat / Dinner & Concert [B, D]

This afternoon from the comfort of a Glaas Bohtham Boet, view beautiful coral gardens and tropical fish inside the calm crystal waters of Norfolk's lagoon. A full and interesting commentary will be provided on this environmental tour. Tonight, enjoy another delicious dinner at your hotel where Paul will take to the stage to make it a memorable last night.

Day 8 – Wednesday 05 May 2025 Depart Norfolk 2.40pm / Arrive Sydney 5.15pm / Melbourne 8.20pm [B]
