Day 1 – Thursday 22 October 2026

Depart Melbourne/Sydney - Arrive Hanoi via Singapore

Welcome to the start of your Songs of Vietnam & Cambodia holiday with Rodney Vincent. Please check in two hours prior to departure. Upon arrival at Hanoi Airport, we'll be greeted by our local guide and transferred to our hotel for check-in. Hanoi, the capital of Vietnam, the city blends tradition and elegance, featuring French colonial architecture, tree-lined boulevards, scenic lakes, and a vibrant Old Quarter. Later in the afternoon, enjoy a one-hour cyclo tour - a chauffeur-pedalled tricycle - through Hanoi's Old Quarter. Welcome dinner tonight will be at a nice local restaurant.

Day 2 – Friday 23 October 2026

Hanoi Highlights Sightseeing

Today with our local guide, we begin our sightseeing with a visit to Tran Quoc Pagoda, the oldest Buddhist pagoda in Hanoi, beautifully situated beside the shimmering West Lake. We then continue your exploration of Hanoi's cultural landmarks. You will have the option to visit either Hoa Lo Prison Museum or the Vietnamese Women's Museum. Next, visit the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university. Its peaceful gardens and historic architecture offer a serene glimpse into the country's scholarly past. Enjoy lunch at KOTO - Know One Teach One - a social enterprise restaurant that trains disadvantaged youth in hospitality. In the afternoon, visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum for an outside view of the imposing marble and granite structure that houses the preserved body of Ho Chi Minh. Please note that the mausoleum is closed on Mondays, Fridays, all afternoons and from late September to December. Return to central Hanoi.

Day 3 – Saturday 24 October 2026

Hanoi Overnight Cruise

Departing from Hanoi we begin our journey heading toward Halong Bay. The drive takes you through the fertile farmlands of the Red River Delta, offering a glimpse into everyday life in Vietnamese villages. Upon arrival in Halong, board our cruise. Spend the afternoon exploring the wonders of Halong Bay - known as the Bay of the Descending Dragon. Discover fascinating caves, pristine beaches, floating villages and dramatic limestone formations rising from emerald waters. As night falls, enjoy onboard entertainment such as movie screenings, squid fishing, or simply relax with a cocktail while surrounded by the majestic limestone karsts emerging from the tranquil waters.

Day 4 – Sunday 25 October 2026

Halong Bay / Hanoi fly to Danang / Hoi An

Early risers may begin the day with a Tai Chi demonstration on the sundeck at dawn. Enjoy a light breakfast followed by a colourful brunch as the cruise continues through Halong Bay, sailing past its 2,000 islets and visiting some of the region's most iconic highlights. Late morning, our cruise will conclude at the pier in Halong.

From there, we return to Hanoi airport for a short domestic flight to Danang. On arrival in Danang, we transfer to our hotel in Hoi An for check-in and overnight stay. Enjoy an included dinner either at your hotel or at a charming local restaurant.

Day 5 – Monday 26 October 2026

Hoi An sights & Walking Tour

This morning travel through the idyllic countryside of Hoi An. Pedal past lush water-coconut forests, tranquil ponds, and seasonal verdant rice fields, soaking up the bucolic scenery and serene atmosphere. We will have the opportunity to glimpse into the rural lifestyle to learn about traditional organic farming techniques. Then enjoy a ride in a traditional 'basket boat' along a small languid river. Lunch today is some delicious Vietnamese local specialties. Once back in Hoi An embark on a walking tour of ancient town Hoi An. Today, this World Heritage-listed ancient town boasts well-preserved buildings, pedestrianized streets and unique cuisine, allowing visitors a glimpse of its illustrious past. The narrow lanes are ideal for a guided leisurely walking tour. Return to the hotel and relax or ask our guide to take you to visit some interesting places processing traditional crafts like lantern making, social enterprise and/or silk & clothes making.

Day 6 – Tuesday 27 October 2026

Hoi An - Day at leisure & Dinner/Concert with Rodney

Today is free for leisure, offering the perfect opportunity to explore the charming town of Hoi An, a protected UNESCO World Heritage site. Known for its hand-sewn tailored clothing and beautiful white sand beaches, Hoi An is ideal for shopping, relaxing by the pool or simply soaking in the atmosphere and people-watching. Depart the hotel by coach for an early dinner at a local restaurant. Following dinner, Rodney will take to the stage to perform.

Day 7 – Wednesday 28 October 2026

Hoi An - Danang / Fly to Saigon / City Sights

After breakfast we depart for the airport for our flight to Saigon. Upon arrival in Saigon, we are met by our local guide. We enjoy a light lunch featuring local specialties such as Pho (Vietnamese noodle soup) or Com Tam (broken rice). We begin your afternoon with a visit to the Reunification Hall, formerly known as the Presidential Palace. Continue with a walking tour along Dong Khoi Street. Admire the beautifully restored exteriors of the Opera House and the former Hotel de Ville. Wander up to the Norte Dame Cathedral, a striking red-brick church with twin spires modeled after its Parisian counterpart and more! Later we depart the hotel for a short drive to a local boat restaurant for an included dinner cruise on the Saigon River, offering a relaxing evening surrounded by city lights and gentle waters.

Day 8 – Thursday 29 October 2026

Saigon - Full Day Mekong Delta Excursion

Today we depart for a full-day excursion to Cai Be, located deep in the heart of the Mekong Delta. Upon arrival, embark on our private junk boat and begin cruising through the region's lush waterways. The first stop is a local home factory where traditional treats such as rice paste, rice popcorn and coconut candies are produced. We continue our journey through the evergreen islands of the Mekong River, navigating a vast network of meandering rivers and countless canals. The tranquil scenery and vibrant rural life provide a peaceful backdrop for your cruise. Enjoy a relaxing lunch at a local house, featuring regional specialties in a warm and authentic setting. After lunch, re-board our junk boat and cruise slowly back to the pier. Return to Saigon in the late afternoon. The rest of the evening is free at leisure.

Day 9 – Friday 30 October 2026

Saigon - Cu Chi Tunnels / Fly to Siem Reap

After breakfast we depart on a two-hour drive northwest of Saigon. Travel through urbanized areas in the lush southern Vietnamese countryside to reach the famous Cu Chi Tunnels. This remarkable underground tunnel network was constructed by Vietnamese resistance fighters (Viet Cong) during their long struggle for independence. In the early afternoon, return to Saigon Airport for your short flight to Siem Reap, Cambodia. Upon arrival at Siem Reap Airport, we are met by our local guide and transfer to our hotel for check-in. During the drive, our guide will provide an introduction to Siem Reap, answer any questions you may have. This evening, enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant or at your hotel.

Day 10 – Saturday 31 October 2026

Siem Reap Sightseeing

After breakfast, our day begins with the gentle hum of a Tuk Tuk waiting outside our hotel, ready to whisk us into the heart of Cambodia's ancient wonders. As the morning light filters through the trees, we'll journey toward the majestic Angkor Thom, the last great capital of the Khmer Empire. South Gate Stop: Enter through the imposing South Gate, flanked by towering stone carvings of elephants and serene faces. Bayon Temple: At the city's center lies Bayon, a mesmerizing 12th-century temple adorned with 54 enigmatic towers, each bearing the face of Avalokiteshvara. Today we glide past the elegant Baphuon Temple, the elevated Phimean Akas, and the evocative Elephant and Leper King Terraces. The Royal Palace grounds and the tranquil Woman and Man Pond offer glimpses into royal life and sacred rituals.

Next we'll arrive at Ta Prohm, a temple reclaimed by nature - one of the most photogenic spots in Angkor. After a short break, the afternoon unfolds at the legendary Angkor Wat, the world's largest religious monument. This evening Rodney will perform for us at a private home where dinner will also be served. It is certain to be a memorable night!

Day 11 – Sunday 01 November 2026

Siem Reap Sightseeing / Farewell Dinner

The day begins with a scenic transfer to the boat pier, where a private vessel awaits to carry us across the tranquil waters toward Kampong Pluk, a unique floating village located about 20 kilometers southeast of Siem Reap. Upon arrival, we'll be immersed in the rhythms of daily life. The journey continues to Buddhist Island, a serene stop where vibrant Buddha paintings offer a glimpse into Cambodia's spiritual artistry. In the afternoon, the adventure shifts to the Angkor Silk Farm in Pouk District, just a short drive from Siem Reap. Tonight, as the sun begins to set, your day concludes with a farewell dinner at a charming local restaurant. Here, we'll savour the authentic Cambodian flavours, reflect on the day's discoveries and celebrate the vibrant culture and warm hospitality that have defined our journey.
