Day 1	Friday 07 August 2026	Depart Adelaide / Depart Melbourne / Depart Sydney / Arrive Auckland Depart Auckland (Cross Dateline) / Arrive Rarotonga / Ariki Night with Fire Show	[D]
Welcome to the start of your tropical holiday. Meet Graeme & Lynne Hugo at Adelaide International Airport, Departures Hall. Depart on Air New Zealand and arrive Auckland. Experience the true taste of the Cook Islands with a dinner prepared in the traditional Cook Island way. After dinner, get ready for an electrifying fire show. A memorable start to an exciting week! Day 2	Saturday 08 August 2026	Punanga Nui Market / Poolside Drinks / Edgewater Island Night Feast & Show	[B/D]
Tropical breakfast buffet is included daily. Today, visit Rarotonga's Punanga Nui Market which offers a wide range of island gifts and handicrafts, black pearls, pearl shell, jewellery, pareu fabrics, clothing, local music and fresh local produce. Meet at Mal's Bar at 5.00pm for happy hour drinks (Drinks at own expense). Tonight, enjoy the fantastic in-house Polynesian Island Night & Show, including a sumptuous feast!			
Day 3	Sunday 09 August 2026	Rarotonga's Churches / Te Ara Museum / BBQ Under the Stars	[B/D]
Sunday is church day, when everything stops in Raro. We travel south to the village of Titikavaka to attend a church service at their Cook Islands Christian Church. Here we'll enjoy a wonderful experience! Hear the locals raise the roof with their renowned beautiful, spine-tingling singing! (Please note: White attire must be worn with long sleeves. Men long pants. Ladies long pants/shirt/dress). Next, we visit the Te Ara Museum, where we will see the world-class exhibition of the history of the Cook Islands with an environmental focus on ocean conservation. Lunch and the remainder of the afternoon are at leisure. Tonight, we indulge in a BBQ under the stars with resident band Ru and the Boys.			
Day 4	Monday 10 August 2026	Rarotonga Orientation Tour / Visit Local School / Concert / Tamarind Dinner	[B/D]
After breakfast this morning we embark on our Island Discovery Tour. This is an excellent introduction to the Cook Islands, and provides information on the country's history and culture, stopping along the way at fascinating historical and ceremonial sites. Light refreshments included on tour. Next, enjoy a relaxed morning with a visit to one of the islands local schools (subject to confirmation at time of print). Meet the students and spend some time with them. This afternoon we return to our resort to freshen up before departing for our dinner at Tamarind House, a popular local restaurant.
