- Day 1 – Friday 20 November**      **ADL/MEL to SYD / Depart Sydney - Arrive Norfolk / Night as a Convict**      **[D]**

- Day 2 – Saturday 21 November**      **Island Life Tour / Dinner at a local home**      **[B, L, D]**

- Day 3 – Sunday 22 November**      **Naturally Norfolk Tour / Dinner & Concert at Paradise**      **[B, D]**  
 Today we join Ataa Orn Tours for this fascinating tour. Formed by volcanic forces millions of years ago, the island's dramatic landscapes are a testament to nature's power. Explore towering basalt cliffs, unique limestone formations and sweeping views across Phillip Island. Wander through the lush Botanic Gardens, home to over 180 native plants, including 46 found nowhere else in the world. - Day 4 – Monday 23 November**      **History in the Making Tour / Dinner at bounty Lodge**      **[B, D]**

View a film, visit a blacksmith's forge, the original homestead, a WWII Army hut and Museum of Memorabilia. Approx 2 ½ hours and includes light refreshments. Late this afternoon depart for 'Orn daa Cliff' a stunning cliff top setting on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline to watch the sunset. Enjoy a delicious feast of local Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by an Island dessert and tea or coffee. While you dine in paradise, you are treated to some local entertainment.
- Day 6 - Wednesday 25 November**      **Thanksgiving Day Picnic / Dinner at Governors Lodge**      **[B, L, D]**  
 In the tradition of the American Whalers who visited Pitcairn Island, join us in the celebration of the gifts throughout the year. We begin with the special Thanksgiving Service at All Saints Church, Kingston and hear the Chapel Choir perform. Afterwards we meet for a true Thanksgiving feast, including turkey, hot veggies, salads and cold meats, traditional breads and much more. Wine and orange juice are supplied as well as delicious Island desserts. This afternoon is at leisure. Tonight depart for Governors Lodge for a delicious dinner in the Boatshed.
- Day 7 – Thursday 26 November**      **BBQ Breakfast Emily Bay / Glass Bottom Boat / Farewell Dinner / Concert**      **[B, D]**  
 This morning enjoy a champagne BBQ breakfast at scenic Emily Bay. There is time at leisure today for fishing and other activities. This afternoon from the comfort of a Glass Bohtam Boet, view beautiful coral gardens and tropical fish inside the calm crystal waters of Norfolk's lagoon. Donald and Les provide full and interesting commentary on the environment tour. Tour time will depend on tides. Tonight, enjoy dinner at your hotel followed by another show with Graeme. It is sure to be a great end to a wonderful week.
