**Day 1 Tuesday 17 November 2026 Depart Brisbane/Sydney - Arrive Adelaide / Half [D]**

**Day 2 Wednesday 18 November 2026 National Wine Centre / Botanical Gardens [B/D]**

After a leisurely morning relaxing or having a wander around the city, transfer to a local croquet club to enjoy a friendly competition of croquet. Returning to the hotel around 5:30-6:00pm, there will be time to freshen up before meeting for dinner at Bistro Sixty5.

**Day 3 Thursday 19 November 2026 Morning at Leisure / Social Croquet Play [B/D]**

This morning, we depart for the National Wine Centre where we will be taken on a guided tour to learn about the history of Australian wine. Following the tour, indulge in a wine tasting featuring a curated selection of premium South Australian wines while learning how to identify aromas, flavours and regional characteristics. Knowledgeable staff provide insights into each wine's origin and style, making the tasting both educational and enjoyable. After your wine experience, take a leisurely stroll into the neighboring Adelaide Botanic Garden, one of the city's most beautiful and tranquil spaces. Returning to the hotel early afternoon, this afternoon will be at your leisure. Dinner is included today.

**Day 4 Friday 20 November 2026 Full Day Barossa Valley Tour [B/L]**

Travel to the world-renowned Barossa, an incredible landscape of vineyards, boasting more than 160 vineyards and some of Australia's finest red wines. You will visit Kies Family Wines followed by the picturesque Jacob's Creek to experience some of Australia's most recognised wines. Take in sweeping panoramic views of the Barossa Valley from Mengler Hill Lookout. Then indulge in a delicious, shared platter lunch and wine tasting at Lambert Estate Wines. Complete your Barossa experience with a visit to Maggie Beer's Farm Shop.

**Day 5 Saturday 21 November 2026 Social Croquet Play / Beerenberg Farm / Hahndorf [B/D]**

This morning, we transfer to a local croquet club to enjoy a friendly competition of croquet. After lunch we will escape the city and discover the charm of Australia's oldest surviving German settlement of Hahndorf, nestled in the scenic Adelaide Hills. The first stop will be Beerenberg Farm, there will be a stop at Mount Lofty lookout which is the highest point in the southern Mount Lofty Ranges. From the summit viewing platform, visitors can clearly see the Adelaide CBD, surrounding parklands, beaches and even Kangaroo Island in the distance. Once reaching Hahndorf, stroll along the charming main street lined with elm trees, boutique shops, galleries and artisan food stores. Visit local craft and souvenir stores, sample handmade chocolates or fudge and explore heritage buildings and learn about early German settlers. Enjoy time to relax over afternoon tea. Dinner is included today.

**Day 6 Sunday 22 November 2026 Social Croquet / Popeye Cruise [B/D]**

This morning, we transfer to a local croquet club to enjoy a friendly competition of croquet. This afternoon we depart from the Croquet Club for Elder Park Landing, which is the starting point of the iconic Popeye cruise along the River Torrens. Dinner is included today.

**Day 7 Monday 23 November 2026 Social Croquet (TBC) / d'Arenberg Cube [B/D]**

This morning, we depart for a local croquet club to enjoy a friendly competition of croquet (TBC). This afternoon will be a visit to d'Arenberg Cube, which is one of McLaren Vale's most distinctive wine experiences. This evening our farewell dinner will be held within walking distance at the luxury Mayfair Hotel. A lovely way to end our fabulous week of croquet, exploration and lots of fun!
