Day 1 – Tuesday 13 April Depart SYD 9:15am / Depart ADL 9:45am / Both DIRECT flights Arrive KUL at 4:00pm [D]

Welcome to the start of your fabulous Melodies of Malaysia Tour with Graeme Hugo. Please check-in at the Malaysia Airways check in counter, two hours to your flight departure. Upon arrival in Kuala Lumpur this afternoon, we will be met by our local tour guide and transferred to our home for the next two nights, Impiana KLCC Hotel Kuala Lumpur or similar (2 nights), a modern hotel ideally located in the heart of the city, close to major landmarks. Tonight, will be a leisurely dinner at our hotel.

Day 2 – Wednesday 14 April Kuala Lumpur City Experience - Dinner/Concert [B, D]

After breakfast, we enjoy a full day discovering Kuala Lumpur's most iconic highlights. Begin with a visit to the Petronas Twin Towers, the world-famous architectural landmark offering stunning photo opportunities and a glimpse into modern Malaysia. Continue to Aquaria KLCC, an immersive oceanarium where we walk through an underwater tunnel surrounded by marine life from across the globe. Later, participate in a hands-on cooking class beginning with a visit to a local market, where we experience the vibrant atmosphere and learn about fresh local ingredients used in Malaysian cuisine. Under expert guidance, we prepare traditional dishes, gaining insight into the country's rich culinary heritage. This evening we will enjoy a private dinner at our hotel where Graeme will entertain us.

Day 3 – Thursday 15 April Kuala Lumpur to Cameron Highlands [B, D]

After breakfast, we depart for Cameron Highlands with a series of interesting stops along the way. We first visit the Sekinchan countryside to experience local agriculture and paddy fields, followed by a visit to the Paddy Museum, a fascinating place that showcases the history and development of rice cultivation in Malaysia. The journey continues to the United Plantations Museum, where we gain insight into sustainable palm oil production. We then stop at Teluk Intan, a charming coastal town known for its leaning clock tower, before continuing your journey and checking in at the Strawberry Park Resort, located on the hillside with charming Tudor architecture for 2 nights. Dinner is included today.

Day 4 – Friday 16 April Cameron Highlands [B, H/T, D]

Today we explore the scenic Cameron Highlands, beginning with a visit to the local market square. We then continue to a tea plantation and factory, where you can learn about tea production, before enjoying a traditional afternoon high tea surrounded by the cool highland atmosphere. We return to our resort for a relaxing evening including dinner.

Day 5 – Saturday 17 April Cameron Highlands to Ipoh to Kuala Lumpur [B, D]

In the morning, we travel to Ipoh which sits in a valley surrounded by limestone hills, which gives the city a distinctive landscape of dramatic cliffs, caves, and greenery. Enjoy a walking tour of the old town, including photo opportunities at the Ipoh Railway Station and St. Michael's Institution. We then continue your journey toward Kuala Lumpur with a stop at Gua Tempurung, where we take a short walk to admire the impressive cave formations. Upon arrival in Kuala Lumpur, we check in once again at the Impiana KLCC Hotel Kuala Lumpur (or similar) for 4 nights.

Day 6 - Sunday 18 April At leisure - High Tea - Evening Tour [B]

Most of the day is at leisure to further explore Kuala Lumpur. This afternoon we enjoy a lovely High Tea at our hotel. Tonight, we begin our evening exploration with a visit to Chinatown, followed by Dataran Merdeka, the River of Life, and Little India. Dinner will be at leisure at one of the many restaurants.

Day 7 – Monday 19 April Kuala Selangor Excursion [B, D]

In Kuala Selangor, you'll find a more relaxed, small-town atmosphere where we experience local poetry giving you a glimpse into the region's culture and storytelling style. The nearby nature parks are also a highlight - places like Kuala Selangor Nature Park are known for mangroves, birdlife, and quiet walking trails where you can connect with the local ecosystem. Then heading up to Melawati where from the top, you get wide views over the coast and the Straits of Malacca, especially beautiful around sunset. In the evening, we witness the enchanting fireflies and, if conditions allow, the natural phenomenon known as blue tears. The day will conclude with a seafood dinner before returning to our hotel.

Day 8 – Tuesday 20 April At leisure - High Tea - Dinner & Concert [B, H/T, D]

We enjoy another day at leisure in Kuala Lumpur, allowing time to relax or explore. Tonight we will enjoy a private dinner where Graeme will take to the stage to entertain us and mark an end to a fabulous holiday.

Day 9 – Wednesday 21 April Depart Kuala Lumpur for SYD 8:00pm or ADL 20:25pm [B]

We have use of our rooms until our departure. Enjoy a day at leisure. Early evening, we transfer to Kuala Lumpur International Airport for our homeward flight.

Day 10 – Thursday 22 April Arrive Sydney 6:25am / Adelaide 7:00am
