**Day 1 Friday 23 October 2026** Depart Brisbane/Sydney - Arrive Launceston [D]

Welcome to the start of your Go See Touring Croquet holiday in stunning Tassie! Enjoy your flight to Launceston. Meet your coach captain and board the comfortable coach to travel to your accommodation in Launceston at the centrally located Hotel Grand Chancellor. Dinner tonight is at your hotel.

**Day 2 Saturday 24 October 2026** City Sights Tour / Tamar Valley / Seahorse World / Low Head [B/L/D]

Breakfast at your hotel. After a relaxed start to the day, enjoy a city sights tour around Launceston. Then, we follow the Tamar River north and pass through the Swiss-style village of Grindelwald. At Beauty Point, we dive into the depths of the Southern Ocean at Seahorse World, a working marine conservation centre. Next, we visit a beautiful vineyard and enjoy a wonderful lunch. Afterwards travel to the picturesque Low Head Peninsula at the mouth of the Tamar River to visit Australia's oldest pilot. Dinner tonight is at a local restaurant.

**Day 3 Sunday 25 October 2026** Evandale Village & Market / Northern Tassie Croquet Centre [B/D]

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning visit the historic village of Evandale, full of beautiful heritage buildings and famous for the Sunday Market, Glover Art Prize and National Penny Farthing Championships. Enjoy time at the market, wandering the wide range of stalls or choose to explore the Village. This afternoon play croquet with the friendly Launceston players at the Northern Tasmania Croquet Centre. Dinner tonight is at a local restaurant.

**Day 4 Monday 26 October 2026** Latrobe Croquet Club / Anvers High Tea / Ashgrove Dairy Door [B/L/D]

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, enjoy social croquet play with members of the Latrobe club. This afternoon visit Anvers Chocolate Factory. Lunch today is a delicious High Tea style lunch at Anvers overlooking the beautiful gardens. On our way back to Launceston, we'll stop at Ashgrove Cheese, where you may watch the cheesemakers in action. Afternoon at leisure and dinner tonight is at the hotel.

**Day 5 Tuesday 27 October 2026** Scottsdale / Legerwood Tree Carvings / St Helens / St Helens Croquet [B/D]

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, we travel to the agricultural town of Scottsdale where we'll stop for a short visit before continuing to Legerwood. Here, we'll view the War Memorial Tree Carvings. Next, we pass through the myrtle rain forest of Weldborough Pass and on to the coastal town of St Helens. This afternoon will be social play at St Helens Croquet Club. Late afternoon is at leisure and dinner tonight is at the hotel.

**Day 6 Wednesday 28 October 2026** Ross / Tasmanian Wool Centre / Bonorong / Hobart [B/D]

Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, we travel to the riverside village of Ross, which was built by convict labor in the early 800s. The rich history of this town comes to life at the Tasmanian Wool Centre, where an extensive collection of artifacts, photographs, and documents are on display. Enjoy a visit to one of the delicious bakeries known for making Australia's best vanilla slice. Next, we visit Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary, where you'll meet and learn about the animals including wombats, echidnas, quolls and Tasmanian devils. Next, travel onto the city of Hobart. Tonight, dinner is at the hotel.

**Day 7 Thursday 29 October 2026** Mount Field National Park / The Wall in the Wilderness [B/L]

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, we leave Hobart behind as you venture to Mount Field National Park, home to the iconic Russell Falls. We stop for lunch at Derwent Bridge Wilderness Hotel. Next, prepare to be moved by "The Wall in the Wilderness", a powerful, ongoing sculpture project crafted from rare Huon Pine. From here we head back to Hobart. Dinner tonight is own arrangements.

**Day 8 Friday 30 October 2026** Croquet at New Town Club / Mount Wellington of Mount Nelson [B/D]

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning will be social croquet play at the New Town club with members from the club. A relaxed afternoon around the city of Hobart includes historic Battery Point, Salamanca Place, Constitution Docks and the waterfront. Tour Mt. Wellington/Kunanyi (weather permitting) or the Mount Nelson Signal Station for panoramic views of the city and estuary. Enjoy some quiet moments in Hobart's Royal Botanical Gardens, vibrant with colours and blooms or choose to explore the city. Dinner tonight at your hotel.

**Day 9 Saturday 31 October 2026** Salamanca Markets / Croquet / Farewell Dinner [B/D]

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, we take the opportunity to explore the famous Salamanca open-air markets. Lunch is own choice and expense. Later this morning, transfer for an afternoon of social croquet play with the members of the Sandy Bay Croquet Club. Tonight's farewell dinner is at the iconic Mures Restaurant.

**Day 10 Sunday 1 November 2026** Richmond Tour / Depart Hobart / Arrive Brisbane/Sydney [B]

Breakfast at your hotel. Today there is just enough time for a visit to the historic village of Richmond. Walk across Australia's oldest bridge, built by convict labor between 1823 and 1825. Visit the cemetery of Australia's oldest remaining Catholic Church, St Johns, built in 1836 or browse through the many delightful craft shops, galleries and cafes. The coach will take you to the airport in time for your flight home.
