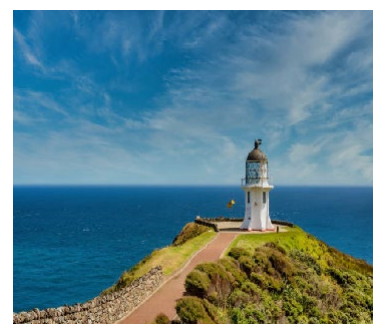

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Day 1 – Thursday 4 March 2027	Arrive Auckland	[D]
Welcome to the start of your Kiwi holiday. Haere mai, Kia Ora! Welcome to New Zealand. Today you are met on arrival and embark on a sightseeing tour of Auckland City en route to your accommodation.		
Day 2 – Friday 5 March 2027	Social Croquet / Sky tower	[B,D]
Transfer by coach to Pt Chevalier Croquet club for a morning of croquet. Late afternoon we travel to the Auckland Sky tower, the tallest tower in New Zealand, featuring 4 observation decks. Dinner tonight is at the Orbit Restaurant.		
Day 3 – Saturday 6 March 2027	Auckland - Whangarei / Croquet	[B,D]
Scenic coastal drive to Whangarei. Visit Brick Bay for a self-guided walk on the sculpture trail, followed by a cheese board and wine tasting paddle. Early afternoon we visit Whangarei Croquet Club. Dinner tonight is at your hotel.		
Day 4 – Sunday 7 March 2027	Croquet / Sightseeing	[B,D]
Transfer to Kensington Croquet Club for a morning of croquet. This afternoon there will be a short sightseeing tour of central Whangarei and the Town Basin and then take a guided tour of the Hundertwasser Art Centre with Wairau Māori Art Gallery, discovering Hundertwasser's extraordinary art and eco-philosophy alongside inspiring Māori exhibitions, all set within one of Whangarei's most striking architectural landmarks. Dinner tonight is at a local restaurant.		
Day 5 – Monday 8 March 2027	Whangarei / Paihia	[B,D]
Travel north from Whangarei to Paihia through rolling farmland and rural Northland scenery. Upon arrival, take a ferry across to Russell, which holds an important place in New Zealand's history, being the country's first seaport, its first European settlement and New Zealand's first capital. Take in the sights of Russell on an intimate one-hour coach tour combining historical knowledge and local insight. Time to grab some lunch (own cost) and then, from Russell, board a half-day cruise out into the clear waters of the Bay meandering around the idyllic beaches of the islands that make this area so popular. Cruise past the Cape Brett Lighthouse, before arriving at the majestic Hole in the Rock. Keep an eye out for common and bottlenose dolphins, whales and other marine life during your cruise. Transfer to the hotel and enjoy dinner in the hotel restaurant.		
Day 6 – Tuesday 9 March 2027	Cape Reinga Day Tour	[B,L]
Enjoy a full day coach tour today which will take you to Cape Reinga, the northern most tip of New Zealand to watch the Pacific Ocean collide with the Tasman Sea and where according to Māori legend, spirits depart on their journey to the homeland - Hawaiki. On the way, enjoy the drive on the vast and empty Ninety Mile Beach, try sandboarding on the dunes and hear stories of these magical places. Dinner tonight is own arrangements.		
Day 7 – Wednesday 10 March 2027	Paihia / Kerikeri	[B,D]
Travel the short distance to Kerikeri this morning, a town with a rich and colourful history. Enjoy a short walk to the stunning Rainbow Falls, on the Kerikeri River. Afterwards, enjoy a guided tour of the Stone Store and Kemp House (Kerikeri Mission House). Time to purchase lunch (own cost) and this afternoon, visit a local winery for a wine tasting before visiting Makana Confections, where you are able to sample their delicious handmade chocolates. Dinner this evening is at a local restaurant.		
Day 8 – Thursday 11 March 2027	Paihia / Hokianga	[B,D]
Enjoy a leisurely morning, then travel from Paihia, through remote Northland countryside, to Hokianga on the West Coast. Hokianga is a place of deep Māori significance where many Kiwi chase their origins to the legendary navigator Kupe, believed to have first landed at the shores of Hokianga Harbour and your hotel is located in picturesque Omapere. This afternoon, visit Manea: Footprints of Kupe, a 60-minute multisensory journey of guided storytelling - through art, Taonga (cultural treasures), film, performance, digital interaction and the splendor of Hokianga's natural surroundings. Dinner in the comfort of your hotel this evening.		
Day 9 – Friday 12 March 2027	Hokianga / Orewa Croquet/ Auckland	[B,D]
Travel from Omapere, down the West Coast through vast kauri forests, stopping to view the ancient giant trees, including New Zealand's largest known living kauri tree, Tane Mahuta. Continue to Matakoho Kauri Museum. Rejoin the main highway and then detour through the quaint town of Matakana to Point Wells to visit Orewa Croquet Club. Afterwards, descend again into Auckland. Farewell dinner at a local restaurant.		
Day 10 – Saturday 13 March 2027	Depart Auckland	[B]
Farewell to New Zealand. Today you are transferred from the hotel to Auckland Airport for your flight home.
